



THE 1986 REUNION

The Reunion format will be the same as last year. Normally the business meetings are held Sunday mornings at 10:00 a.m. BUT PLEASE NOTE: THE BUSINESS MEETING THIS YEAR WILL BE HELD SATURDAY, JULY 19, 1986, AT 4:00 p.m.

As we did last year, you may arrive anytime Friday afternoon or night. We suggest you do because that's when everything really starts. If you can't come Friday, please make sure you're there on Sat. before 4:00 p.m. so you can register and be at the meeting on time. All business of the Association will be conducted at that meeting. On Sunday at 11:00 a.m., there will be a social meeting where we will have the memorial service, introductions of those present, a possible speaker and other activities.

As was the case last year, please note that no meals will be served at anytime Friday. You must make other arrangements on this, like going into town or whatever.

### DIRECTIONS TO CAMP LONE STAR

Immediately south of La Grange on Highway #77 South (to Victoria), is a bridge spanning the Colorado river. About 150 yards from the southern end of this bridge is a sign saying "CAMP LONE STAR." Turn on that road (east) and go 2 miles to the camp, simply following the signs. One-half mile is paved, the other  $1\frac{1}{2}$  is dirt but usually in very good condition. Park, register in the RETREAT CENTER, unload your car and get set for a relaxing time. Bring your charming personality with you, please:

#### MEALS

Please DO NOT BRING FOOD OR SERVICE. You won't need any! Full meals will be served, buffet-style, all you can eat. There will be three neals on Sat. and 2 on Sunday (breakfast and lunch)---BUT NO MEAL ON FRIDAY.

#### ROOMS

Being a 1st class retreat, the rooms sleep either 4 or 6--so you can pick your own roomnates, preferrably some who don't snore! The rooms are air-conditioned and very nice. Linen, plankets and pillows are furnished.



COST

The cost is definitely reasonable and will be determined by your arrival time. If you're there  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days, you'll have 5 full meals, 2 lodging nights (Fri. & Sat.) plus full use of all facilities at a cost of \$61.20 per adult and \$38.50 per child--HOWEVER--maximum charge per family will not exceed \$180.00 for all  $2\frac{1}{2}$  days. Age 5 and under--no charge!

If you arrive Sat. or Sun., your charge will be prorated from the above figures.

PLEASE DO NOT SEND ME ANY MONEY for room and board as this will be paid directly at the registration desk--BUT DO FILL IN THE FORM at the end of this Newsletter and return it to me so that Camp Lone Star can get an idea of our head count.

#### VANS AND CAMPERS

Vans and campers are allowed as long as there are not too many of them and are SELF-CONTAINED. There are no hook-ups available. Also be warned, there are no level parking areas for them. The Hosts do not encourage this much and I don't think the price reduction warrants bringing them anyway.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:35 p.m.




# Annual REUNION
