#### Heritage Trip

Last September, 12 members of the vonRosenberg family experienced a trip of a lifetime as they spent three weeks on the vonRosenberg Family Heritage trip which took them to Latvia, Lithuania, the Czech Republic, and Germany, with a bonus side trip for an afternoon in Salzburg, Austria. The two-fold purpose of the trip was to visit the homeland of Peter Carl and family, as well as retrace part of the trek they made from Eckitten to America. With the help of a splendid tour guide and a bus driver who was willing to go well above and beyond the call of duty, they located Eckitten Estates just outside of Klapeida, formerly known as Memel. It was a very moving experience to walk the land of our forefathers. Their guide led them in a German folkdance, and Leah Green, the youngest traveler, climbed a tree and wrapped a red, white, and blue bandana around one of the branches as a token of our German and American heritage. Many castles were visited, including the castle Rozmberk, not far from a quaint little town, Ceske Krumlov in the Czech Republic. This was one of several castles that was originally occupied by the vonRosenberg family in the Renaissance period.

Joining the group was our cousin, Alexandra vonRosenberg and her friend Erika Reiker, who live in Munich. The last stop before coming home was Munich, where they had the great honor and pleasure of meeting Alexandra's sister and 95-year-old mother, Zeppie. Zeppie and Alexandra both shared stories of their life during World War II. They were living in Riga, Latvia when they had to evacuate to Poland, then on to England, before they could eventually return to Germany. Members of the tour were Glenn and Jo vonRosenberg, Ray vonRosenberg, Clois and Nettie Green, Art, Susan and Leah Green, Reba Wright, Laura Wingo, Ann Barnes, and Ruth Holt. Laura at 87 was the oldest traveler, and Leah at 13 was the youngest. Clois Green celebrated his 85th birthday while on the trip.

Pictures, videos and stories will be shared by members of the trip at the reunion. This will be the activity for Saturday night following the reception at the Meerscheidt House.

#### Cost

he cost at Camp Lone Star is reasonable and compares favorably with any other manner of financing your reunion expenses. The cost is pro-rated and is determined by your arrival time.

Please get your reservation in as soon as possible for rooms at Camp Lone Star. If you cannot come all weekend, come early Saturday to take part in our day trips and the afternoon's activities.

The best price is a package price: Spend the full 2 1/2 days and you'll get 5 full meals, 2 nights lodging, plus full use of all facilities for approximately \$105.00 per adult (18 years and older); about \$68.50 per youth (ages 8 to 17); children age 7 and under w/parents are free.

If you come part of the time: \$30 per night (\$20 for youths 8-17) and \$15 per meal (\$10 youths 8-17) which includes a mandatory facility use charge. Facility use charge includes a meal plus the use of the facility as well as use of any accommodations such as swimming, volleyball, basketball, hot tub, etc. Part time costs are approximate.

RVs and campers are not recommended since there is no place set aside to park them.
